RE:	Hunter Bowls/E-Luggage's status as an NMP licensee

Please be advised that effective from September 1, 2021, Hunter Bowls (HB), also known as E-Luggage (EL) will not hold a licence to sell apparel as part of the National Merchandise Program (NMP).

For clarity, please note the following:

- All licenced apparel carrying the BA NMP logo purchased from HB/EL prior to September 1 is deemed as compliant apparel under the NMP policy.
- Any orders for licensed apparel carrying the BA NMP logo placed prior to September 1 with HB/EL can still be completed by HB/EL, irrespective of when the order is expected to arrive. This apparel is deemed as compliant under the NMP from September 1.
- From September 1, HB/EL **will not** be able to accept any new orders for apparel carrying the BA NMP logo. Any orders placed from this date will be deemed as non-compliant under the NMP policy.
- Any retailers carrying Hunter Bowls stock with the BA NMP logo, can continue to sell this stock past September 1 until depleted. This apparel will be deemed compliant under the NMP policy.
